# **City on the Move:** Building on Worcester's Transportation System

In September 2018, the Worcester Regional Research Bureau released *City on the Move: An Overview and Assessment of Worcester's Transportation Needs.* Worcester has been a transportation center for centuries, leading to its status as an important population and economic center for Massachusetts. Worcester has significant infrastructure necessary to move people and goods in and out of the city. Yet as industry and technology change, the city needs to regularly reconsider its transportation infrastructure and address the future potential of such opportunities as increased density and innovations like automation and electrification.
